Program Design

This course will cover basic medical terminology, common phrases, and cultural considerations that are vital for building rapport and providing quality care to Spanish-speaking only individuals.

This course includes straight forward grammar explanations and medical terminology along with cultural nuances that arise in the medical setting with your Latino patients.

Key Lesson Concepts:

- Introductions, greetings, leave takings and general courtesy phrases
- Basic medical terminology and cognates
- Key Power Verbs, allowing you to ask pertinent medical questions and give prescription and follow up instructions
- Promote preventive care
- Improve rapport and engagement
- Effective communication strategies to enhance education

How to use this course

- 1. **Memorize the terms relevant to your specific field.** The vocabulary lists have been carefully selected to correspond to common healthcare-related conversations.
- 2. Maximize your learning by using this technique
 - a) Start by watching the presentation from the beginning.

- b) Try to memorize the vocabulary, read and/or listen to it as many times as you need. The first few times, just attempt to obtain the general idea.
- c) Repeat words and phrases aloud as much as possible to reinforce the structures and to mimic the accent and intonation.
- d) The more you listen to the presentation and review the terms, the more you will improve.

The goal is to help you assemble the sentence structures that suit your specific needs.

The purpose of this course is to teach you to communicate with your Spanish-speaking only patients to form strong clinician—patient rapport. This presentation's objective is to teach the sentence structures needed to form your own key phrases, to suit your own specific needs.

If a word or concept related to your specific field is not mentioned, simply learn to use the sentence structure, and add your own specialized term. In this way, you will learn how to say whatever you need to.

Remember, you can review the presentations, terms and key phrases as often as you need. Regular review is key! It won't be long until you realize how much medical Spanish you've learned.
